

OYSPPMA Inspects Progress, Verifies Completed Solar Street Lighting Projects Across Ibadan



The Oyo State Project Performance Monitoring Agency (OYSPPMA), on Thursday, April 2, 2026, conducted a comprehensive field inspection of solar street lighting installations across Ibadan, aimed at assessing the progress of the project and confirming completed installations.

The exercise forms part of the agency's statutory responsibility to monitor government projects and ensure delivery aligns with approved specifications and timelines. It also seeks to validate contractors' claims of completion while identifying areas where work is still ongoing.

The inspection spans multiple local government areas within the Ibadan metropolis, covering key residential neighbourhoods, major road corridors, and commercial zones.

Among the locations assessed are Alalubosa GRA, the Bashorun Water Reservoir axis, Iyanganku–Magistrate Court area, and several streets within New and Old Bodija. Commercial hubs like the Agbowo Shopping Complex, as well as major routes including the Felele–Idi-Odo corridor, were also included in the verification.

The exercise focused not only on confirming completed installations but also on evaluating overall project progress across different locations, including whether ongoing works align with expected standards and timelines.

OYSPMA reiterated its commitment to transparency, accountability, and evidence-based monitoring, noting that the exercise is critical to ensuring public infrastructure projects deliver their intended benefits to residents.

The solar street lighting initiative forms part of the Oyo State Government's broader efforts to improve public safety, enhance nighttime visibility, and stimulate socio-economic activities across the state.
